**Environmental Issues** [Dean Lammering] The goal the Task Group is a revision of the Cooling Tower Manual - Chapter 7. The task is approx. one half completed with the remainder outlined. The writers for the remaining sections have been assigned – due date is prior to the Annual Conference 2007, so a completed document can be reviewed at that time.

**Water Reuse Document** [Phil Kiser] The Task Group worked on a rewrite of the document, which has been completed, and it will be forwarded to Vicki for submittal to CTI approval cycle.

**Cooling Water Performance: Microbiological Monitoring** [Walt Tyler] A draft of the Task Group document has been consolidated and completed. The document will be routed for editing – J. Zibrida, P. Grayson, M. Trulear, A. Brunn.

**Filtration of Cooling Tower Systems** [Clarence Melancon] The Task Group will provide a Guideline document to discuss the benefits of filtration in cooling water systems. Target for a draft document is Winter Meeting 2007.

**Oxidizing Biocide, WTP-141** [Dwight Emerich] The Task Group Chairman was absent from the Summer Meeting. Sections on hydrogen peroxide and monitoring and control methods were added and discussed. This Task Group should be consistent with the work in the Micro-Biological Monitoring Task Group. This Task Group will be active at the Annual Conference 2007.
